**Subject: 2nd Round of Counseling - Reservation for In-Service doctors in
DNB/Diploma seats of NBEMS – 2021 Admission Session.**

Dear Sir/Madam,

1. Several NBEMS accredited DNB/Diploma seats in the Government Hospitals / Institutions of Puducherry have already been forwarded to the Medical Counseling Committee (MCC), DGHS, Government of India for inclusion in **1st round of Counseling 2021 for All India Quota seats**. On the other hand, upto 50% DNB / Diploma seats have also been retained by the State for its in-service doctors which shall be filled through State Quota Counseling to be conducted by the State itself.

Apart from the above, **some new DNB/Diploma seats** in the Government hospitals of Puducherry have been accredited by the NBEMS for inclusion in the counseling 2021. Since the DNB/Diploma seats for 1st round of counseling has already been forwarded to the MCC, these additional / new seats shall be included in the **2nd round of counseling 2021**. The list of accredited hospitals having Post MBBS DNB seats for 2nd round of counseling is at **Annexure-1**. The list of accredited hospitals having Post Diploma DNB seats for 2nd round of counseling is at **Annexure-2**. The list of Post MBBS 2 years Diploma seats for 2nd round of counseling are at **Annexure-3 (PDF and MS-Excel File)**.

2. The number of new NBEMS seats in Government hospitals of Puducherry available for inclusion in **2nd round of counseling 2021** is tabulated below:

The admission to Post MBBS DNB & Post MBBS Diploma seats will be done through NEET PG 2021 whereas the admission to Post Diploma DNB seats will be done through NBEMS PDCET 2021.

3. As per the extant policy, up to a maximum of 50% of Post MBBS DNB seats, 50% of Post Diploma DNB seats and 50% of Post MBBS Diploma seats can be reserved for In-Service doctors of the Concerned State (Only the doctors working in a Government organization on a regular basis in the concerned State and have qualified NEET PG 2021 or PDCET 2021 whichever is applicable, are eligible for allocation of seat reserved for In-Service doctors).

4. The maximum number of seats which can be reserved for In-Service doctors in your State/UT is tabulated below:

5. The counselling for admission to the seats reserved for In-Service doctors shall be done by the State Government itself after applying the applicable statutory reservation as per the applicable policy, regulations/eligibility. Seats retained by the State Government to be filled from In-Service doctors will not be included in the All-India counselling, in case such seats remain vacant after the counselling conducted by the State Government.

6. The remaining Post MBBS DNB seats, Post Diploma DNB seats and Post MBBS Diploma seats shall contribute to the Central Pool of the seats and is tabulated below:

The numbers in the above table (i.e. at Point No. 6) will increase if your state/UT opts for lesser number of seats as per the table in Point No. 4. Please ensure that the total number of seats in the Table at Point 4 & Table at Point 6 should match table in Point No. 2 for each type of seats.

The counselling for the All-India Quota Seats (i.e. the Central Pool Seats) shall be done on all India basis by the Medical Counselling Committee, DGHS, GOI. For these Central Pool seats, the State Government is required to indicate the reservation status (SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PWD/Unreserved) for each seat in the format enclosed at Annexure-4. A sample format for a ready reference is at Annexure-5.

7. The following information has to be provided to NBEMS:
- i. Seats retained by the State Government (to be filled from In-Service doctors) in the format at Annexure-6.
 - ii. Seats not retained by the State Government i.e. Central Pool seats in the format at Annexure-4.
 - iii. Seats, if any, which are not to be included for 2021 counselling.
8. In case any of the hospital as mentioned in Annexure-1, Annexure-2 & Annexure-3 does not come under the ambit of State Government, the seats for such hospital should not be decided by the State Government and the same is required to be informed to NBEMS.
9. The above information regarding the DNB/Diploma seats for 2021 admission session has to be provided to NBEMS at email id anurag@natboard.edu.in and acc4@natboard.edu.in

by 13-12-2021 so that the seats can be included in the 2nd round of counseling for 2021 admission session.

10. The state is at the liberty to utilize less than 50% of seats for In-Service doctors. In case the State Government does not want to retain any seat for In-Service doctors i.e. 100 % of seats of the State will be contributed to the Central Pool, the State would be required to indicate the reservation status of each and every seat in the format at **Annexure-4**.
