- 01) Tenders should be submitted through on-line in the prescribed form Notice Inviting Tender (NIT) upto 17.00 hrs on 14-02-2025 in official website https://pudutenders.gov.in as specified therein. The tender details, terms and conditions and specifications, time schedule may also be downloaded from the website https://igmcri.edu.in for reference only.
- O2) Apart from submitting online tender, each tenderer (for Technical Bid) should be submitted in a single cover and details of Tender fee & EMD super scribing "relevant name of Ophthalmology Medical Equipment (Item Name) and (for example: Supply of Posterior Vitrectomy Equipment should also be submitted in a separate cover and to reach the Chairperson, Tender Committee, Indira Gandhi Medical College & Research Institute, Puducherry, Vazhudavour Road, Kathirkamam, Puducherry-605009 on or before 17-02-2025 at 17.00 Hrs.
- 03) Tenders will be opened by the Tender Committee on 17-02-2025 at the Indira Gandhi Medical College and Research Institute, Vazhuthavur Road, Kathirkamam, Puducherry 605 009.
- 04) The Chairperson, Tender Committee (Director of Indira Gandhi Medical College and Research Institute) is competent to accept the tender in whole or part and also have the right to reject any / all the tenders without assigning any reason there for.

- 05) Every Tenderer must go through the terms and conditions carefully and understand themselves before submitting their tender. Any request that the conditions have not read or understood properly will not be entertained later.
- 06) The Tenderer shall be the manufacturer of the item offered or Authorised Dealer of the manufacturer or Direct Importer of the item. The Authorised Dealer shall enclose a copy of the letter of appointment for Authorised Dealership issued by the manufacturer along with the Tender. The Direct Importer shall enclose tender, a copy of the letter of authorization issued by the manufacturer and also a copy of the valid import license issued by the competent authority along with the tender.
- 07) The Chairman, Tender Committee / the Indenting Officers of IGMC&RI has the right to increase or decrease the quantity of the articles mentioned in the schedule or not to order any quantity or any number of any such articles at all during the period of tender/contract.
- 08) Any attempt on the part of the Tenderer or their agent to influence the department will disqualify such tender.
- 09) The Companies / Firms which have been blacklisted by any State Government / Central Government / its procurement agencies should not participate in the tender. However the participants should give an undertaking that they have not been blacklisted by any State / Government / Central Government / its procurement agencies. Any violation of Tender norms may lead to blacklisting of the Tenderer by the Institute for 3 years.
- 10) The tenderer must pay Rs.1,180/- as Tender Fee in the form of Demand Draft drawn on any nationalized bank, in favour of the Director, Indira Gandhi Medical College and Research Institute, Payable at Puducherry. The DD will be taken only in the name of the firm without fail. The Tender fees must be submitted along with the submission of Technical Bids.
- 11) The tenderer must pay EMD of Rs.40,000/- by way of Demand Draft drawn on any nationalized bank, in favour of the DIRECTOR, IGMCRI, PUDUCHERRY, Payable at Puducherry. The name & Seal of the firm has to be written on the reverse of the Demand Draft without fail. The EMD must be submitted along with the submission of Technical Bids. No interest will be paid on E.M.D.

EMD Exemption: Terms and Conditions

1. Firms requesting EMD exemption must submit valid supporting documents such as MSME/NSIC certificates or any other relevant government-approved exemption proof.

- 2. Exemption is applicable only to firms meeting the criteria outlined in the tender document.
- 3. The exemption request must be submitted along with the Technical Bid; late requests will not be entertained.

Documents to be submitted for EMD Exemption:

- 1. A valid MSME/NSIC registration certificate or equivalent government-authorized exemption document.
- 2. A formal request letter seeking EMD exemption.
- 3. Any additional documents specified in the tender conditions.
- 12) The earnest money will be returned to the unsuccessful tenderers, but retained in the case of successful tenderer to be adjusted towards security deposit @ 10% required to be paid by the successful tenderer for due fulfillment of the contract.
- 13) Income Tax Clearance Certificate for the last three years i.e., from 2021 2022 to 2023-2024 should be enclosed with the tender, failing which the tender will be rejected. If the tenderer is not an Income Tax assessee, a non-assessee certificate issued by the Income Tax Department should be enclosed. **Permanent Account Number (PAN)** of the Income Tax, GST registration / TIN should also be enclosed.
- 14) The supply should be made at the supplier's own risk, if damages and breakages occurring in transit, the articles thereof should be replaced. No insurance charges will be payable.
- 15) The firms should quote the basic price of the items separately and the other taxes and duties only as mentioned in the Bill of Quantity (BOQ) of the Tender Schedule.
- 16) The rate quoted should be valid for a period of **one** Year from the date of approval of rate by the Government.

THE FIRMS ARE REQUIRED TO QUOTE THEIR LOWEST RATES COMPARABLE TO THE RATE QUOTED FOR OTHER INSTITUTIONS ELSEWHERE. THE QUOTED RATE, IF FOUND AT A LATER DATE TO BE HIGHER COMPARED TO THE RATES OFFERED TO ANY OTHER INSTITUTION, THE DIFFERENCE IN COST WILL BE LIABLE TO BE RECOVERABLE / ADJUSTED FROM THE EMD ETC., OF THE SUPPLIER FIRM.

17) Tenderer will not be allowed at any time and on any ground whatsoever, any claim for revision or modification of the rate quoted by him during the currency of the tender/contract period.

- 18) Tenderer not stipulating the period of delivery and tenderer with price variation clause / subject to prior sale conditions shall be rejected.
- 19) Exact amount / rate to be quoted, should be quoted in Indian currency, by the firms and no change at a subsequent date is allowed due to the change in the convertibility of Indian rupees.
- 20) The supply should be delivered within a period of 30 days from the date of issue of supply order. In case of delayed delivery, penalty at the rate of 1 % per week, of cost of the items not supplied will be levied. If the delay exceeds 4 weeks, the order will be treated as withdrawn; unless otherwise the delivery time is extended by the indenting officer.
- 21) Selection of tenders would very much depend upon the efficacy / quality of the products offered. Sample / Demonstration if required, should be produced / arranged before the Chairman at the expense of the tenderer / Tenderer. The Tenderer /Tenderer shall be bound to deliver all the articles in such quantity or numbers and within such time as the Chairman, Tender Committee / Indenting Officer shall from time to time direct during the currency of the contract. All articles shall be subject to inspection and acceptance or rejection by the Chairman, Tender Committee / Indenting Officer.
- 22) The price to be quoted shall be "Firm" in all respects and for delivery F.O.R destination PUDUCHERRY and should cover Excise Duty, Packing, Forwarding, Transportation, all incidental charges and insurance etc., No advance payment will be made except, for import items for which L.C has to be opened.
- 23) All items should be supplied strictly in accordance with the approved specifications. The article supplied by the Tenderer which in the opinion of the Chairman, Tender Committee / Indenting Officer is found faulty or unfit for use shall be rejected. The opinion of Chairman thereon in all respects will be final and conclusive and altogether operative and binding on the Tenderer and shall not be open or subject to question or dispute by the Tenderer on any ground whatsoever. If the equipments are not satisfactory and do not meet the specification offered by the firm the same will have to be removed from the institution immediately after receipt of intimation at the firm's own expenses. If not, the equipment will be sent to the firms' by this Institute & the charges towards transport and other incidental charges will be recovered from Security Deposit amount paid by the firm.
- 24) The item supplied in lieu of or in substitution of rejected equipment shall in like manner be subject to inspection or rejection and removal as often as the Chairman, Tender Committee, shall consider necessary.

- 25) The firm (Supplier) shall submit bill (in duplicate) along with an advance stamped receipt immediately after execution of the supply order in full, for arranging payment. The payment will be made on receipt of said equipment at site in good condition / commissioning of the equipment and inspection of the Technical Advisory Committee, subject to fulfillment of all other terms and conditions of agreement to be entered into subsequently.
- 26) <u>PAYMENT TERMS:</u> Payment shall be made on receipt of the item on time of supply and complete in all aspects. No advance payment to be paid.
- 27) The tenderer shall invariably furnish the GST & PAN certificates with their bills along with account details for payment.
- 28) In case of any difference or dispute arising in connection with this contract, all legal proceedings relating to the matter shall be instituted only in the court within the jurisdiction of the Union Territory of Puducherry.
- 29) The tenderer should accompany the Questionnaire with the undertaking enclosed duly filled and signed. Failure to do so, will lead to non-consideration of the tender.
- 30) The BOQ template must not be modified/replaced by the bidder and the same should be uploaded after filling the relevant columns, else the bidder is liable to be rejected for this tender. Bidders are allowed to enter the Bidder Name and Values only.
- 31) EVALUATION OF BIDS: The Committee constituted by the Department will evaluate the Technical Bid. The specification offered by the companies will be evaluated based on the specification of the Department. Based on the Technical Evaluation, the Financial Bid of such short-listed companies will be opened for further evaluation. The bidders or their representatives shall be called for opening of the Technical Bid.
